Muhammad ibn al-Hasan in "Al-Misbah" narrates from Al-Sadiq Ja'far ibn Muhammad (A) that he said: "Whoever wants to visit the grave of the Messenger of Allah (PBUH) and the grave of the Commander of the Faithful (Ali), and Fatimah, and Hasan, and Husayn, and the graves of the divine proofs while in his own country, should do ablution on Friday, wear two clean garments, go out to an open space, and pray four units (rak'ahs), reciting whatever is easy from the Quran. When he completes the prayer and salutes, he should face the Qiblah and say: Peace be upon you, O Prophet, and Allah's mercy and blessings. Peace be upon you, O Prophet, the chosen one, and the faithful guardian, and the great lady, and the pure lady Zahra, and the two chosen grandsons, and the children, and the noble ones, and the trustworthy mourners. I have come in devotion to you and your fathers and your descendant, the successor, with the blessing of the truth. My heart is at peace with you, and my assistance is prepared for you until God decrees by His religion. I am with you, with you, not with your enemy. I am among those who

acknowledge your virtue, confessing to your return. I do not deny God's power nor claim anything other than what Allah wills. Glory be to Allah."
