God does not fear the reproach of any reproacher, and He does not retreat. A successful person, due to their differences and advancements compared to others, may sometimes face the scorn of others. However, the disdain and humiliation of others do not affect them. On the other hand, their progress is not in worldly matters where they would compete with materialists. Their success lies in the maximum flourishing of their own talents and those of others, based on divine plans.

Kamil al-Tammar said that Imam al-Baqir (peace be upon him) said: "O Kamil, the believer is a stranger; the believer is a stranger." Then Imam al-Baqir said, 'The believers who have submitted to God are the chosen ones.'"
